The FSSS-CSN is demanding **improvements** to working conditions in five areas:

- Humanize care and services
- Value personnel and increase their sense of belonging
- Address wrongs and injustices
- Take care of workers
- Protect and decentralize public services





The health and social services system needs some TLC. Structural reforms are not enough. The government must take care of its employees!

There is only one way to get better working conditions: we must organize to make gains.
